

***There was an error in Motif 2, this is the correction and a way to also use the one with the mistake.**

MOTIF 2 -

Center Motif you will be making two.

SECOND ROW.....

1 RING: 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, close, reverse work, CHAIN: 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds reverse work

2-11 RING: 3 ds, p, 3 ds, attach to the next to the last picot in the previous ring, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, close, reverse work, CHAIN: 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, reverse work

12 RING: 3 ds, p, 3 ds, attach to the last picot in the previous ring, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, attach to the second picot in the first ring, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, close, reverse work, CHAIN: 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cut thread about 6 inches, attach to the base of the first ring. Secure trimmed thread ends with either glue or sewing on the back side.



CENTER ROW.... I did not make this first because I could not pull a ring close without breaking the thread. So I Chained 1 ds, p, p, p, 1ds between each of the center picots. This also prevented the oval from falling out.

Attach thread to one of the center picots of the second row, **CHAIN: 1 ds, p, p, p, 1ds** stitches away the second row which will have you going counter-clockwise around the center, attach to the next center picot, and repeat all the way around. When finished, stop where you started, cut thread about 6 inches, attach to the center picot where you started. Secure trimmed thread ends with either glue or sewing on the back side.



CONNECTING OUTER ROW.... Put the two motifs back to back so that the front is showing on both sides when finished. **MAKE SURE BOTH SIDES ARE CONNECTED AS YOU TAT.....**

With a fine crochet hook, pull thread through aligned two picots on the front and back center motif, pass shuttle through and tighten down... **NOTE: put the oval in when you have two or three sets of picots to join.**

CHAIN: attach to both picots front and back motif one of the chain segment, 4ds, attach the next Picots(front and back motif at the same time) on the same chain segment, 8 ds, attach to the next picots in the next chain segment, 4 ds, attach to the next picot in the same segment, 8ds, to the next two picots (front and back motif at the same time) repeat all the way around, back to where you started, cut thread about 6 inches, attach to the base of the first ring. Secure trimmed thread ends with either glue or sewing on the back side. **NOTE: 4ds chain between the 2 picots, 8 ds between chain segments.**

***If you created the motif with the error, try this OUTER EDGE to put them together:**

Put the two error Motifs, back to back. SHUTTLE and BALL, attach to one of the picots which aligns front to back, CHAIN: 6 ds, skip the center picot on the chain, connect to both third picots (front and back), CHAIN: 8 ds, attach to the next two picots in the next chain segment (front and back) CHAIN: 6 ds, attach to both third picots (front and back), CHAIN: 8 ds,.....repeat all the way around.
